

## Rebecca Maria Elizabeth (Barbadoes) Walker

B 1860 in Boston

Robinson Female Seminary alum

M. dec. 1875 in Exeter to Frank Walker (first child William F. born in March 1876) Civil War vet.

Had 6 children in Exeter. Lived on Oak St, Brentwood Rd, etc

Divorce: 1897 Court records abandonment, drunkenness.

D. 2/24/1922 in Cambridge, MA

Exeter Cemetery database: Date of entombment 2/28/1922, burial April 1922. Lot not noted

Undertaker, Fleming. Lot #1301 purchased by eldest son William F Walker in April 1922

6 spots on West, (6 spots on East later exchanged by son Joseph in 1967, of Everett, MA)

2W. (? William b. 1876, **d 1935**)

3W. Phillip Austin Walker, b. 1890, **d. 1956** (military-issue marker WW1) only child that remained in Exeter for lifetime. Possibly worked at Ioka.

4W. Ethel M Walker b. 1883, **d 1958** (photo from Robinsons Seminary) 

5W. Florence Walker b. 1878, **d 1963**

6W. Isabelle Walker b. 1887, **d. 1967** (blind, attended Perkins School in Boston)

Children 3-6 were unmarried.

William F. was married, but died 30 years before his wife. No living children.

Child Charles died very young in 1887, and is buried in single deed grave #450

Child Joseph R B, b. 1888, moved to Cambridge became optician. He married college grad Carrie Cooke. Their two children (Joe Jr, Phyliss C.) earned graduate degrees from Boston University in 1940. Neither had living children. That whole family lived at 44 Pierce Rd, Everett, MA. Joseph R B died in 1972. Joe Jr d. 1993.
